THE BOSTON POST CANE

Boylston Honors its Eldest Citizens

In 1909 the Massachusetts based *Boston Post Newspaper* had 700 ebony-shafted, ornate gold capped canes made and provided them to Selectmen of towns in Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island, requesting that the canes be presented in a ceremony to the town's oldest living man. Women became eligible for this honor in 1930. It was originally planned as a one time offering, but the gesture to our much-respected senior citizens was so popular that it has continued for decades. In Boylston, the actual transfer of the gold headed cane was discontinued in 2019, but the ceremonial honor by the town to the eldest citizen remains a vibrant part of our community with a gold cane pin being awarded at the ceremony. The Boylston Historical Society & Museum has in its collection the gold headed cane.

At this time, we are seeking to create a list of the Boston Post Cane recipients or the oldest person in Town of Boylston over the years. The Boylston Historical Society & Museum wishes to honor these individuals and welcomes information on any of these Boston Post Cane recipient individuals or others who were honored as our oldest citizens.
